


## VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL

## **Annual Conference Report**

The Mississippi-West Tennessee Conference held a Special Called Session of Annual Conference at Madison Methodist Church on June 12-13. Though we had just met this past January, we needed to meet to vote on a few items and ordain some new pastors.

We began on Wednesday, June 12, with workshops that covered a variety of topics like Family Discipleship, Church Planting, Prayer, Global Missions, and Biblical Holiness. Most sessions were standing room only.



Wednesday night we held an ordination service where Bishop Scott Jones ordained 8 new pastors: 2 Deacons and 6 Elders. One of the new Deacons was Lee Ann Williamson who is currently pastoring a church plant in Bay St. Louis. You may remember Lee Ann from when she came to share with us about the Global Methodist Church one Sunday.





Thursday morning Bishop Jones shared a wonderful message on Evangelism and Discipleship. And then, later that morning, we held our business session, which lasted less than an hour.

As part of the business session, we approved our proposed Conference Budget for 2025. Total budget for 2025 will be \$735,897. A full breakdown of projected expenses is available on the Mississippi-West Tennessee Conference website: <a href="https://ms-wtngmc.org/annual-conference">https://ms-wtngmc.org/annual-conference</a> The chair of our conference Finance Committee is our own Rich Knox.

We also elected our delegates for the upcoming Convening General Conference. There are 7 lay and 7 clergy delegates, with 2 alternates each. So, we will be sending 16 representatives to Costa Rica this September.

Rich Knox was elected to serve as a lay delegate, and Brother Lauren was elected as a clergy delegate. Both will travel to San Jose, Costa Rica for the General Conference held September 20-26.

Finally, we approved a new mission partnership with the two new Provisional Conferences in the Philippines, in addition to our current partnership with Angola.
